

Foreword

Moroccan Meetings on Solid State Chemistry (REMCES) are scientific conferences devoted to the physical chemistry of condensed matter. They are organized regularly since 1983 in various Moroccan universities.

It has become a tradition for many international scientific gathering skills in the various fields of chemistry of condensed matter. The REMCES result in the participation of researchers from different nations wishing to collaborate to develop high-level research.

Since 2009, this event has become the official scientific meeting of the national network on the physical chemistry of materials REMAT.

The last meeting was held REMCES XI at the Faculty of Sciences of Kenitra in 2009, bringing together over 300 researchers from different countries.

Meeting “REMCES XII” will be held in Casablanca from 21 to 23 November 2012. It is intended as a platform for exchange and sharing of knowledge, experience and expertise in Materials Science. It will be an opportunity for participants to know the different developments and innovations in this field.

The main objectives of REMCES XII are:

- To review the progress of research work in various fields of physics and chemistry of the solid state: materials and nanomaterials (glasses, polymers, cements, ceramics, metals, alloys, composites,), synthesis, characterization, enhancement, properties and applications, modeling.
- Ensure the publication and dissemination of best works presented.
- Contribute to the development of international cooperation in the Maghreb and the field of scientific research.
- Promote synergies and relations of scientific cooperation between the Maghreb and Moroccan researchers and industrialists working in the field.
